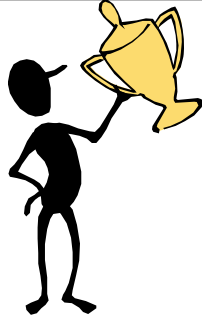

Monthly Brain Teaser!



How quickly can you find out what is unusual about this paragraph? It looks so ordinary that you would think that nothing is wrong with it at all, and in fact, nothing is. But it is a bit odd. Why? If you study it and think about it, you may find out, but I am not going to assist you in any way. You must do it without coaching. No doubt, if you work at it for long, it will dawn on you.

Last Month's Answer: Weigh 3 balls vs 3 balls. If equal, weigh one of the remaining two balls vs the other of the remaining two balls, and the heavier one is apparent. If one set of three is heavier than the other, discard the lighter three, and weigh one of the three vs another one. If equal, the third one is heaviest, otherwise the heavier one is apparent.
