Directions: go north on route 611 to Street Road. Turn LEFT onto Street Road, and go for about 1.5 miles till you reach Special Equestrians.

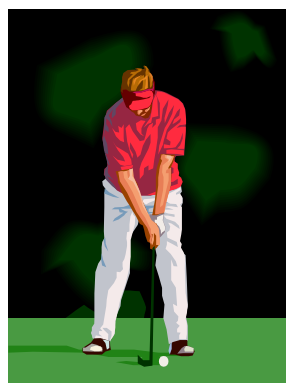
2003 Golf Tournament Update
