## Lions visit Special Equestrians

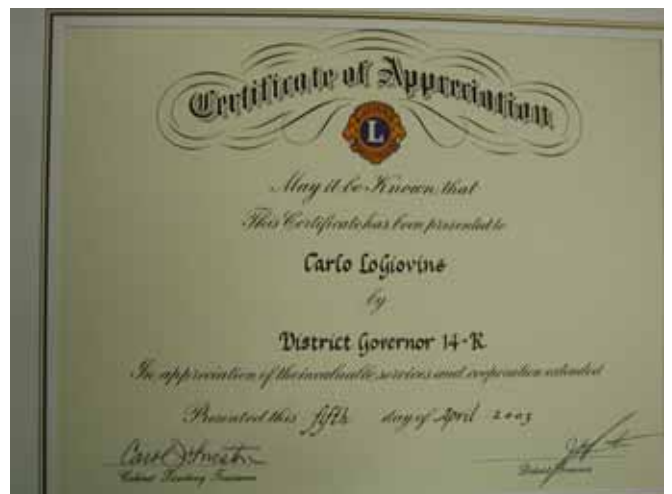
