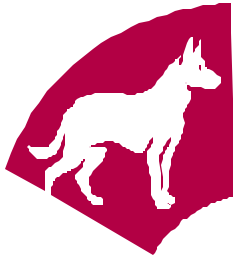
Leader Dog Guest Speaker

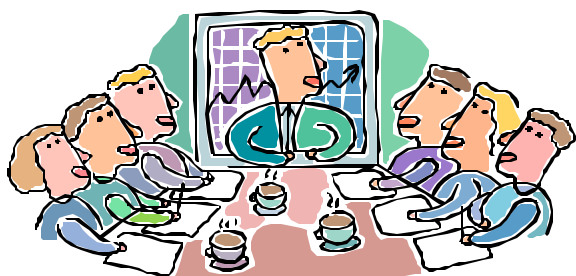
