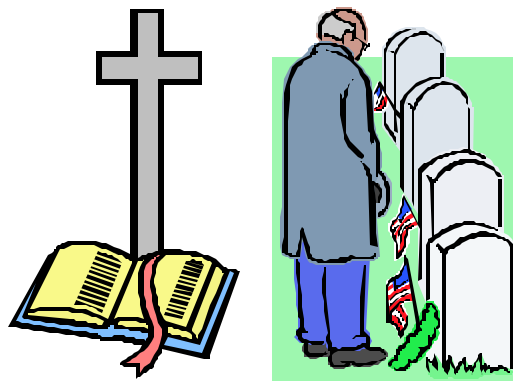
Sal was former chairman of the Horsham Republican Party, and served as committeeman for 42 years.
