During our February 7th meeting, District Governor Joanne George and Vice District Governor Steve Hilbmann visited our club. Luckily for all, the weather didn't ruin our plans, as in years' past.

DG George's theme involved "Tweaking It": even if we make minor changes to things like membership initiatives or meeting format, a small change is better than no change. Tweak little things where possible, rather than stagnate.

She stressed the themes of increasing membership, as well as increasing our presence and participation online (ex: submitting club reports). She reminded us that many helpful and informative seminars will be held at the upcoming convention, which we are encouraged to attend.

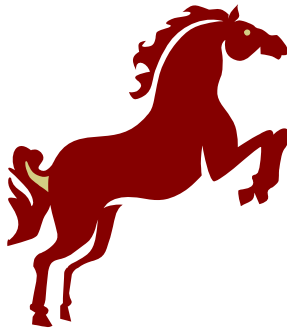


## JT Binstead and Narberth Lions Visit
