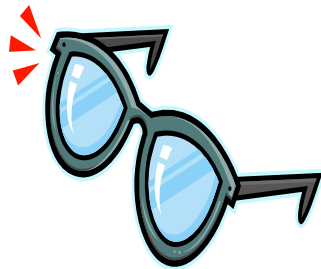
Guest Speaker
