After expenses, the Lions earned over \$2,100, which was the most we have ever earned on Horsham Day. We sold out of roast pork around 6:30pm, long before we have in years' past. We sold out of water too. And we only had a handful of sodas left over.

The Lions earned \$160 from the sale of water ice and ice cream, which was new this year. Thanks to Joe Turchi and Donnie Edmunds at Tori's Water Ice for giving the Lions a generous portion of their profits. We also will be getting a percentage of the Souderton Lions Club's profits selling funnel cakes and lemonade.

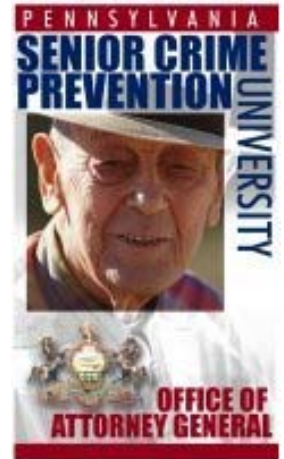
