David Shallcross (pictured) from the PA State Attorney General's office came to speak to us about identity theft, credit card

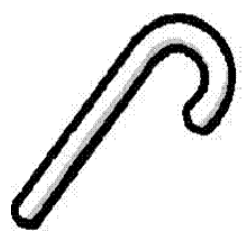

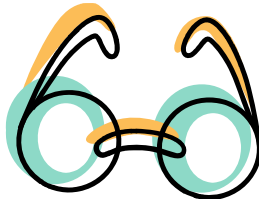
Lion **Allen Weinstein** has agreed to be the chairperson for this endeavor. He'll need help from our membership, so please offer your support!

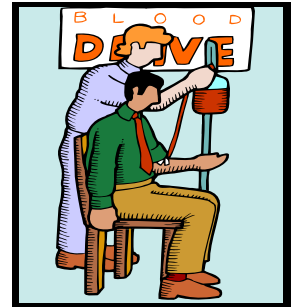
→ The **50/50 raffle** winner from October 15th was John Bill, who took home \$16. The club has earned over **\$400** from the 50/50 raffles in just one short year!
